

Philanthropy Report

Cancellation Policy

Members must provide at least 72-hours notice in order to cancel a shift and notify the SLOBs Volunteer Coordinator listed in the event details in Track it Forward. If you are uncertain who to contact, please email the VP Philanthropy. Members who are canceling within 72 hours of an event should make every effort to find a replacement.

Canceling with less than 72-hours notice and/or not showing up for an event is not acceptable. Members who give no notice before missing an event ("no-shows") will receive a warning for their first offense. A second or more "no-show" will result in the members' accrued service hours being deducted for the same number of hours that they signed up for at that event.



If a member has a last-minute emergency and must cancel the same day of a scheduled event, they must communicate this to the Volunteer Coordinator and/or VP Philanthropy.

Asst. VP Philanthropy / Kai Gomez

We have updated our cancellation policy to a 72 hour window. It was our experience last month that one of the events had multiple cancellations within 48 hours and it was just too late to find replacements, which really let down the philanthropy. Members who are cancelling 3 days before an event should still make every effort to find a replacement.

We understand that there can be last-minute emergencies, but we do not want regular cancellations within the 72 hour timeframe. Of course, not giving notice and/or not showing up for an event is also not acceptable. Members who give no notice before missing an event ("no-shows") will receive a warning for their first offense. A second or more "no-show" will result in the members' accrued service hours being deducted for the same number of hours that they signed up for at that event.

If a member has a last-minute emergency and must cancel the same day of a scheduled event, they must communicate this to the Volunteer Coordinator and/or VP Philanthropy. Thank you for your understanding.
